



Teams: Each team will consist of at least 10 players, two must be females and two must be kids (14 or under, any gender).

Format: Each team will play a minimum of 2 games. Games will be 30 minutes long. If the game ends in a tie, a kickoff will occur to determine the winner. One player from each team will get a kick, whoever kicks the farthest wins.

Scoring: Score by rounding the bases and reaching home plate. The maximum amount of runs that you can score in an inning is 6.

Fielding: Each team must have one pitcher and one catcher. No field players can be in front of the pitcher's plate. Only one player per base.

Pitching: The pitcher delivers the ball. The ball must be rolling to be counted as a fair pitch. If the ball passes through the strike zone and the kicker does not make contact, it counts as a strike. A ball that goes wide of the strike zone or is not rolling will count as a ball. Four balls result in a walk.

Kicking and Running: The kicker must run to first base after any ball that is kicked. Foul lines extend out from first and third base, and a ball must be inside these lines to be in play, otherwise it's a foul. One run is scored every time a runner reaches home. There is no base stealing and no leadoffs.

Outs: Each team gets three outs per inning. A kicker is out if three strikes are thrown, three fouls, or a combination of both that equals three. A kicker is out when the fielding team touches a base with a ball before the kicker arrives, or is he/she is hit with a thrown ball (no headshots).
